## **Technical Help Guide**


Our vision for *Prophecy Today UK* is to build an online community of believers who can talk about our articles and discuss what is going on in the nation and the world from a biblical perspective.

On the *Prophecy Today UK* website, comments can be posted at the base of articles through the Disqus service. Registration with Disqus is required (this is **free**) - read on for our start-up guide.


## **Getting Started with Disqus**

Follow the steps below to register with Disqus. N.B. You can log in to Disqus using your Facebook, Twitter or Google account – see the final page of this document for details.


1. Go to any *Prophecy Today UK* article page and scroll down to the comments at the bottom. Click in the 'Name' box, just below the 'Start the discussion' box.




2. Fill out the form which appears and click the grey arrow beneath (this should change colour to a darker grey when the form is filled out).



**3.** A message should appear asking you to verify your email address. A verification email should arrive automatically in your inbox after a few seconds, asking you to click a link. If you do not receive this email, click the link in the message below to receive one.



**4.** Once you have verified your email address, you should automatically be logged in and able to post comments. When you write in the 'Start a discussion'/'Join the discussion' box, a new button should appear enabling you to comment, reading 'Post as [your username]'. Your username should also appear at the top right-hand corner of the comments box.



5. If you try to post but the buttons do not read as above, you may need to log in again.

You can do this by clicking the 'log in' button at the top right-hand corner of the comments box, or by clicking the 'D' icon just beneath it. Clicking on the social media icons allows you to log in with your existing Facebook, Twitter or Google account.
