In late 1940 three ships arrived in Haifa harbour crammed with precious Jewish refugees escaping the Nazi tyranny. The British authorities had an unjust and grievous plan to send them to detention in Mauritius on a large ship, the Patria, as a deterrent to the flow of Jews coming from Europe. A Jewish underground plan to disable the ship went wrong and it sank with the loss of 200 Jewish lives, plus 50 crew and British soldiers. According to the Balfour Declaration and the Mandate for Palestine the British should have welcomed the Jewish refugees to their ancient homeland and this tragedy would not have happened.
